Rhythm & Accompaniment Styles

What makes playing CP67 more fun are the rhythm & accompaniment styles. You can play as though with a backing band or a full orchestra. A variety of styles can be selected from the 16 presets. Each style has an Intro/Ending pattern, Fill-In pattern and a variation of Basic patterns.

1 - 2 Play

One, Select your favourite style. Two, Press the 1-2 Play button. Now play! The CP67 automatically sets the panel settings (sound, tempo, etc.) to match the style you select.

Sound

The CP67 uses our critically acclaimed Harmonic Imaging sound technology. It reproduces the Kawai concert grand piano EX sound, with remarkable depth, from delicate pianissimos to bold fortissimos. Besides the concert grand piano, sounds of strings, brass, organ and many others are available (GM2 compatible).

Touch

Kawai's Advanced Hammer Action IV brings the superb response touch with accurately balanced weighted hammers and without the use of springs. The weighted action feels heavier on the lower keys and lighter on the upper keys, just like a real acoustic piano giving a smooth feel that will satisfy even a professional.

Concert Magic

Concert Magic is Kawai's exclusive feature which lets anyone play music instantly. You can play any of the 40 preset Concert Magic Songs by simply tapping any key on the keyboard with your own tempo and expression.
